

- viii. Informing pf/DTU securities regarding outsiders worked somehow well. May be next time we can ask and inform pf for security help. ask PF for security policies.
 - Volunteers working at the entrance shouldn't be in charge of kicking intruders out
- ix. Usually feedback on songs "Salsa is the largest group, and therefore contributes the most to the budget, so there should be more salsa songs."Even though a clear printout was made listing the order of songs.
